- Six of our members representing Northern Region in the Trans Tasman series

Life Saving Report

This year as a Club, Orewa Lifeguards gave over 5000 hours back to the community in patrol time, performing 13 rescues, 125 first aids, and countless prevention actions involving over 2000 people. The numbers are quite staggering, and worthy of mention first up. The key is simple, everyone doing their bit. Thank you to all who gave their time freely to keep our beaches a great place to play.

For people to give up their time, they have to feel valued and also get a sense of enjoyment from the activity. The patrol captains this year did a great job of keeping members stimulated and challenged, through scenarios, training, fitness activities and varying the patrol activities. Over the past couple of years we have been trying to bring younger Patrol Captains through, backed by experienced Vice Captains, and the feedback is that we are on the right track. I have seen a lot of growth and maturity in these emerging leaders.

The Club exists to patrol the beach, and patrol must come first. The more you give, the more you get back. Simply turning up to patrol is not enough. Come ready, ready to save a life, ready to get involved, ready to do a little more. Why not this year, put yourself on a first aid course, learn a new skill or volunteer to take on some more responsibility in your patrol? You will be well rewarded.

I must thank the team of Instructors, in the various disciplines. Our instructors put a lot of energy into presenting interesting and dynamic courses that will set you up well for the skills required. They gave a huge amount of time, and take a lot of pride in their work. We also have new Instructors coming through. The quality, and sheer numbers of candidates going through is what drives all the lifesaving activities we do. Well done team. Congratulations to our newest lifeguards.

Remember, there is so much more to be a lifeguard than patrolling, it can lead to being a Regional Lifeguard, maybe working on the Jet Ski squad, event guarding, overseas exchanges, patrolling other beaches, and certainly a great thing to put on your CV for any job application. So, start thinking about where you want your lifesaving skills to take you, talk to some of the guards who have been involved in these great experiences and get started!



Finally, next year, the season will come around very quick once more. Keep watching for updates on training, patrol lists and patrol activities. Think about improving your skills and knowledge, and be prepared to step up just a little more.

Senior Surf Sports Report

This past year has seen some great sporting results as well as some significant management changes within Surf Sports. I would like to thank the Surf Sports Committee, the athletes and support team for the time and effort put in to run the sports program. It has been a big year with the a number of athletes changing age groups, refinements in the management structure, new processes, reporting, etc.

This year also saw a change to the Head Coach and coaching structure. Gavin Elmiger has now completed his two year tenure with the Club and is now focusing on his NZ Canoe role. Zac Franich was appointed as the Clubs Head Coach in March. I would to thank Gavin for the work that he has done in developing the competing squad and wish Zac all the best in preparing the squad for the upcoming season.

Another significant change in the Sports Committee and structure has been Tony Olsen confirming his departure as the Team Manager. I wish to thank Tony for the work he has done over the last few years organising the events for the senior sport team. Tony has advised that he will still be seen on the beach as a carnival arena manager and or as a master's competitor. Cameron Lockie and Michelle Taylor have taken on as a shared role as the Club's Team Manager. I wish them all the best in the senior surf sports.

This year the Club was again generously supported by both current and new sponsors. With the help of these sponsors, the sports team received a new surf boat, canoe trailer, competition pop up tent, four single and a double ski and storage container. Additionally, we cannot forget our regular donors who helped with the up keep of our competition gear and transportation equipment. The new Fundraising Committee is working on building relationships with our sponsors to help secure new sports equipment in the future.

The surf sports results for the past year has been a bit of a mixed bag. The season started off promising with our Master's wining the NZ Pool Championships last September. Prior to Christmas, 6 athletes from our Club were selected and competed for Northern Region in the Trans-Tasman competition. The Eastern and then Northern Regional Championships saw individuals and Teams perform very well. At the Nationals, Orewa was seen on the podium eight times including gold medals to Grace Kaihau and Stefan Powney. Tom Burgess performed well with a 3rd place Overall in the Masters 30-39 age group and then a day later receiving a bronze medal for his part in the Open Ski relay.

At the completion of the National Championships, Ella Drinnan, Grace Kaihau and Stefan Powney were named in the New Zealand Youth Development Squad. Subsequently Grace has been named in the New Zealand Youth Team to compete in Queensland in September.

It was unfortunate that unforeseen circumstances diminished the large squad preparing to compete at the 2015 Aussie Nationals. Eventually Stefan Powney and

James Scott were the only two travelling members of the Club. The Aussie Nationals are a large step up from our National Championships. James did particularly well by progressing through to the Grand Final of the U17 Ski Race and Quarter Final of the U17 Board Race. Stefan progressed very well through the field, but just missed out on the finals.

The Club Day was again well fought and the level of competition is only rising in the U16 and U19 fields. This year at the Northern Region Awards of Excellence, three of the clubs athletes have been nominated for the final selection. I would to thank all that were involved in the last year, congratulate all who have stood out and attained excellence and wish all the best to Grace Kaihau, James Scott and Stefan Powney for the upcoming awards.

Junior Surf Report

This season has been the most successful sports season for Orewa Junior Surf Club in living memory of the club.

Orewa Junior Surf Club won the Cath and Eddie Cup this season, the first time in over 15 years. Similarly in the Northern Region Junior Championships, Orewa won a collective total of 18 Gold medals, 10 Silver medals and 11 Bronze medals gaining first place.

We also enjoyed an outstanding performance at National Level at Oceans15, coming 3rd overall - the best result we have ever had.



This amazing result was the culmination of great parent support, dedicated coaches, managers and committee members, and some very talented athletes.

Our success in the sports arena can be summarized as follows:

- 1st Cath and Eddie Millar cup.
- 3rd Oceans 15 National Championships
- Lucy Makaea (under 14 girls) won the twilight series for the season
- Levi Ata 1st equal U/14 Boys twilight series
- Bernadette Doyle, Lucy Makaea, Xander Cuff, Levi Ata all finalists in the Under 14 sportsperson of the year award at the Northern Region Awards of Excellence.
- Michael Johnston finalist for Surf Coach of the Year at the Northern Region Awards of Excellence.

Unfortunately 2014/2015 sees the end of an era with Mike (Jock) Johnston finishing his last season with C group as he is moving up to help coach our U/16 squad. His knowledge of Surf Lifesaving skills is second to none at the club and his advice is sought after by parents, children and other coaches. He will be sorely missed by the Junior Club.

Through recognition of sponsorships, and proactive engagement of parents to the wider cause of the club, we have had an increase of over 18% in membership numbers. This can be seen as follows.

We have enjoyed a good level of interest from Junior parents for coaching and official courses as a result of in-house education at younger age group levels. This has been achieved through early education to new club members and parents.

We have identified our next key area of development in Junior surf, that being the support and implementation of a tangible succession plan for coaches and managers moving through the Age groups, as well as a need for more robust communication to, and from, our members through a variety of channels, particularly as the club continues to grow. This started with our end of season feedback meeting which was well received by all. The 2015/2016 season will see the introduction of an induction day, off beach, on the first day of training to enable better communication with our membership.

We have built on our focus of building core safety skills within our membership, with a good number of athletes gaining their 200m patch.

The Junior committee has continued building on its successful fundraising activities delivering again the Season Welcome beach party, Quiz night, weekly BBQ, the catering for the Northern Regional Junior Age group Champs, and bar coordination for the Senior prize giving. And continue to look for new and innovative ways to support and fund our growing membership and increasing role within the community.

The Junior Camp continues to grow year on year. This season saw it being held a week earlier than normal which resulted in well prepared athletes at the Waipu Competition the week after. The participation, involvement and fun enjoyed by all at camp symbolises our approach to the junior surf programme. We look forward to another successful season next year.
