Our sponsors for their continued and loyal support, no matter how big or small.



Life Saving Report

This year marks another successful year on Orewa Beach with no drownings or serious injuries, a number of successful rescues and a high number of first aid's and preventions.

This year has also marked an increase in the number of event guarding opportunities off our beach. Tom Burgess has done an amazing job of coordinating a high number of events and the lifeguards who attend them. This year we have increased the professionalism and reputation of Orewa Surf Club, with the added



benefit of raising much-needed funds for the club. I urge anyone who is considering taking part in these interesting and dynamic events to contact Tom Burgess or to join the Orewa Surf Event Guarding Facebook page where you will be kept in touch with upcoming events and opportunities.

This was also the year of the inaugural Patrol Hours Recognition scheme. This very successful programme rewarded those who had completed a high number of patrol hours. This year the top 15% of patrollers were awarded a small scholarship to be credited towards future developmental courses and other club costs. Orewa New World kindly sponsored the scholarship fund and we look forward to working with them in the future to reward those who put in extra effort.

The Instructors team this year have worked overtime to see an extraordinary number of new guards obtain their Surf Lifeguarding Award. Instructing is a rewarding way to give back to the club and to ensure the future of our patrol member base. Instructing also increases your own skills and exposes you to opportunities within the greater Northern Region lifesaving family.

Patrolling is not possible without the dedicated efforts of the Patrol Captains. At the conclusion of last season, we got together with the PC's and debriefed the opportunities for the coming year. This year the Lifesaving Committee implemented those recommendations, some of the things you may have seen included smaller patrols which allowed greater involvement of individual members, and fewer patrols.

One of the other ideas we received was that it was difficult to provide guards to patrol at Wenderholm on New Year's Day and Boxing Day. This year we obtained funding to pay a small number of guards to patrol during this key period which allowed the remaining members to enjoy the Christmas break.

Also the season saw the birth of the inaugural Grey Patrol. The Grey Patrol is designed to bring in members that have been out of patrolling for a number of years and are keen to return to patrolling. It also is targeted at members who are actively involved in the management of the club but would still like to contribute a small number of patrols. The Grey Patrol was very busy and well supported and will continue for next season.

I wish to thank the members of the Lifesaving Committee for the massive hours that they have put into it, the passion that they have shown towards improving our professionalism and skills. I encourage any members who wish to become involved to simply ask. Every little bit counts.

Senior Surf Sports Report

This past year has seen some great sporting results across all the sporting divisions, being swimming / pool, beach, board / ski, canoe and boats in individual and team events. I would like to thank the Surf Sports Committee, the athletes, Surf Officials and supporters for the time and effort put in to run the sports program. Also on behalf of the Sports Division, I would like to thank all our sponsors and those who have donated time, resources and financial contributions to the sports team. Without these contributions our sports program would not be able to be completed.



We did suffer a serious loss this season, with the passing of Peter Young, aka Hori. Hori provided over 40 years of coaching, surf training, personal training and mentorship to athletes and competitors across a range of codes. Surf was a large passion of Hori's and many of us have benefited from his guidance and leadership. In the more recent years you would see him on the beach or grassed area coaching our beaches or land crabs (beach sprints and flags). You will be missed.

This has been a season of growth. It started with Zac Franich undertaking his first year as our Head Coach, secondly the U14 section received a large influx of competitors transferring through from a successful Junior division and thirdly the retention of existing senior club competitors. Our Master division remained stagnant in numbers throughout the season, but still provided a force to be reckoned with.

This year a number of new initiatives were introduced with the primary goals of developing a team culture including training camps, lifting the general fitness of competitors through cross fit training sessions, developing a senior leadership group to help manage and guide the younger competitors. The feedback has been positive and we can only see growth in the future.

To ensure that our competitors compete to the best of their abilities, Sarah Thomas has been engaged to develop a swim training squad out of the Leisure Centre. The results from this swim squad was starting to show through, with the hope this season will see more results. Zac, together with his senior squad, have continued to develop the board and ski disciplines. The results may not quite have shown themselves at the right time during the season; however, the base has been developed for the coming season. The boat division saw eight regular competing crews this season, which is one of the largest in NZ. During the two Regional Champs and the National Champs, these teams accumulated 24 medals, which 8 were 1st placings and 2 of these were gained at the NZ Champs. The Titans won the Open Men's Short Course and Orewa Stars won the U23 Womens Long Course. In addition, the Baby Blues won the NZ Boat Series U19 Womens title. Overall Orewa was placed the second best Boat Club in New Zealand for 2015/2016, only a few points behind the leading Club.

This year saw another season where a large number of Orewa athletes were selected in Regional Teams, New Zealand Youth Development Squads and the New Zealand Youth Black Fins squad. In addition, Tom Onley was selected for the Great Britain team to attend the Sanyo Cup in Tokyo. All of our athletes performed to an amazing standard which made the Club proud. For the coming season, Zac has been appointed as the Coach for the Northern Regional Trans Tasman Team. This demonstrates that our competing team is being recognised by their abilities and the backing of the training program.

The Club had five athletes attend the Aussie Nationals, being Stefan Powney, Cole Drinnan, Grace Kaihau, Lucy Makaea and Levi Ata. Grace made the Grand Final in each of her seven disciplines with Stefan and Lucy each progressing through to a Grand Final each.

At the recent Northern Region Awards Evening, Orewa won three senior sports awards with Lucy Makaea winning the U16 Sportswoman, Grace Kaihau winning the U19 Sportswoman and the Masters being awarded the Masters Team of the season. The season finished off with a combined Club Day incorporating senior and junior club member, with parents trialing the boats and canoes. From this we have at least 1 other master's women canoe crew preparing for the coming season.

On the beach we have strengthened our focus of building core safety skills within our membership, with a larger than average number of athletes gaining their 200m patch.

The Junior Camp continues to be an important part of the Junior calendar. This season it was held the week of the carnival which saw a drop in numbers and general buzz around camp. The upcoming season will see it shift back to a week before the carnival when many parents have time off.

Based on last year's feedback we have developed a more robust communication channel with our managers focusing on their own groups and utilising facebook more often which has been a great success.

We have a huge number of officials assisting in junior carnivals which has been a pleasure to see on the beach, with plans to have even more complete the officials training programme by the end of next season.

We have identified our next key area of development in Junior surf, that being the support and training of new coaches and managers to be able to carry the club forward.

The Junior committee has continued its successful fundraising activities delivering again the Season Welcome beach party, Main fundraiser (Hori Housie), weekly BBQ, the catering for the Northern Regional Junior Age group Champs, and bar coordination for the Senior prize giving. And continue to look for new and innovative ways to support and fund our growing membership and increasing role within the community.

We look forward to a rebuilt committee and fresh ideas and way forward in 2016-2017 season.

Surf Life Saving NZ Life Membership

Congratulations to our President, Wayne Franich, who was awarded Life Membership of Surf Life Saving New Zealand at the 2015 Annual General Meeting in late 2015.

Wayne has been fully immersed in surf lifesaving at all levels for over 40 continuous years.

He joined Orewa as a 14 year old and has risen through the ranks to be a senior leader at club, regional, national and international levels. In his early years he was a



successful athlete in Surf Boats and Canoes and won 2 national titles.

He followed his children into Junior Surf and became a coach, manager and surf official. He then moved into the senior club and assumed senior management roles at club level. He has been on our Board for a number of years and held roles as Chairman and President continuously for nearly 15 years (and counting).

At regional level he has been a member of operational committees and a major force in Surf Sports for many years. He was on the Board of Directors of Northern Region for 5 years retiring this year because of his other commitments. He has become one of the senior surf officials in the country. Originally running the Boat Arena, he is now the Event Referee for the National Championships and other national sport events. Surf Boat racing has enjoyed a significant renaissance under his guidance.

In 2015 Wayne was appointed to the International Lifesaving Federation Sport Commission - which is a testament to the high regard that he is held in, not only in

New Zealand, but also internationally.

Wayne is only the third member of our club to have this honour bestowed on them and the first for nearly 40 years.



Northern Region Life Membership

Congratulations to our Chairman John Chapman (Botch) on being awarded Life Membership of Surf Lifesaving Northern Region. He is the sixth Orewa member to receive this honour.

A second generation member, Botch rose through the ranks as a Junior Lifeguard into senior ranks (and then masters) and has given over 40 years' service to surf lifesaving. He has been a stalwart of our club for many years.

As well as being a major contributor to our club, he sits on committees at Northern Region and is a senior surf official at Northern Region and New Zealand levels.



Interestingly, Northern Region have four father and son Life Member combos – three of those are Orewa members. Alan and Wayne Franich, Mark and Bert (from Piha) McCarthny and now Botch and his father – John Senior.




