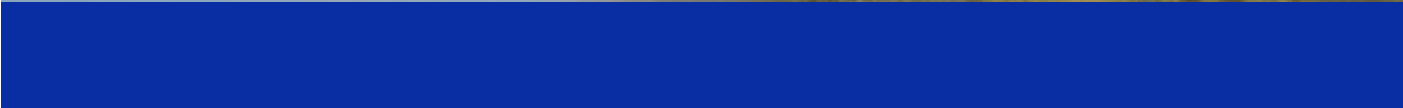

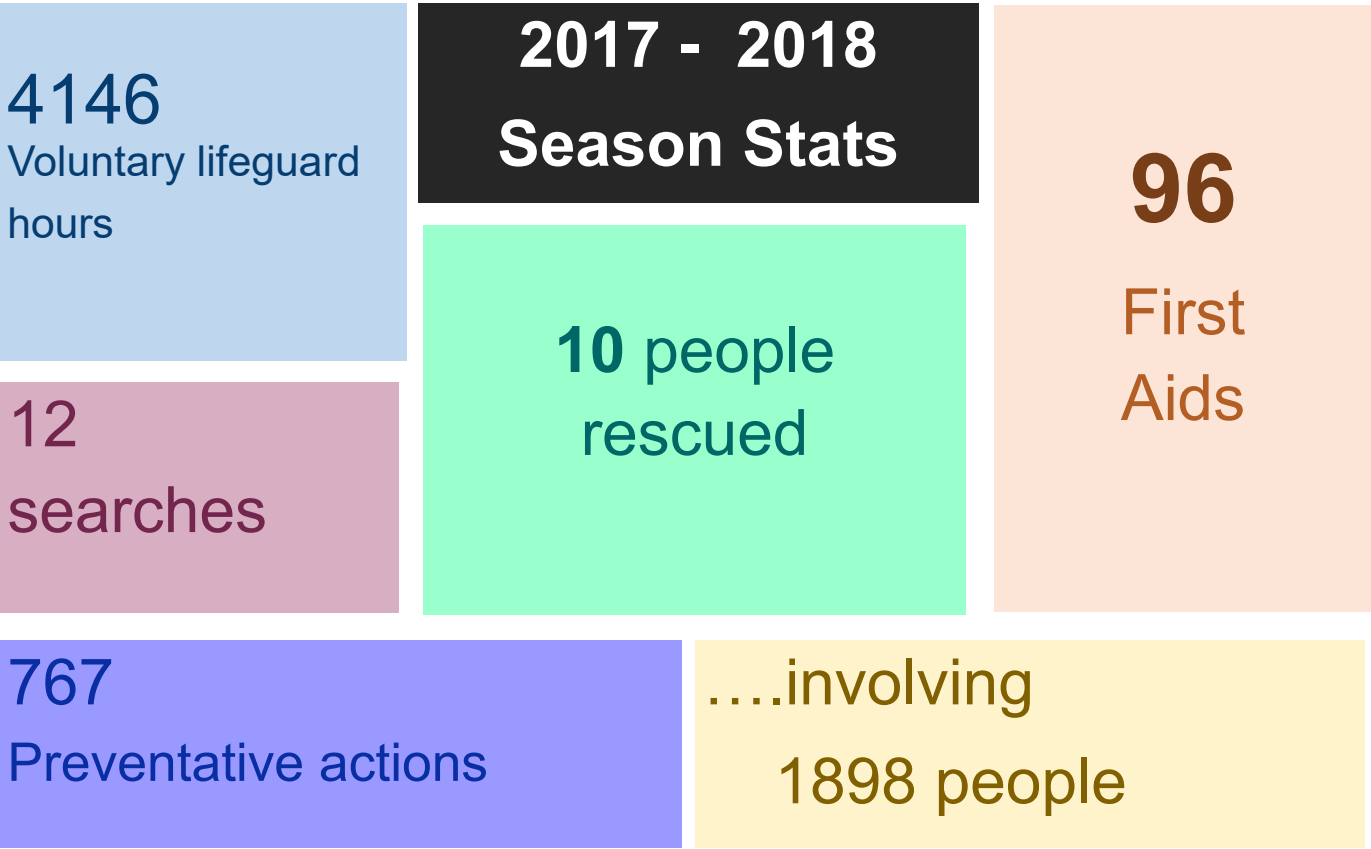

Our season started off on a great note with the 2017 Awards of Excellence for Surf Life Saving Northern Region.

Orewa Surf Life Saving Club was awarded two great lifesaving awards:

- Yamaha Club of the Year
- Best Patrolled Beach

Our members also featured amongst individual sporting and lifesaving awards. Notably for lifesaving:

- Faron Turner being named Examiner of the Year
- Service awards being presented to Ian Siddins and Trevor Keinzley
- Life membership being awarded to John Chapman

We have many things to be proud of as a club including who we are as the people who make up our membership.

This season we have provided support through a number of event guarding events for our greater community and also had a great representation at Oceans 18 through filling roles of first aid, arena safety officers and officials.

We have continued to develop partnerships with our lifeguarding communities through extending support to our smaller regional clubs. This has included providing additional lifeguards and skills support to Mangawhai and Raglan which has also provided our lifeguards an opportunity to provide services in more challenging sea and surf conditions. We have also extended our partnership with Bethells Beach where we have had the opportunity to run IRB West Coast training sessions in the lead up to our IRB crew and driver exams.

We continue to grow as a club and introduce new candidates to the joys and challenges of lifeguarding. In the 2017/2018 season we qualified 17 new lifeguards. As we qualify new lifeguards it is a constant reminder that this is the beginning of the lifeguarding journey and that there are so many pathways and opportunities to develop and grow. This year we have tried to be more active in identifying and promoting these opportunities for and to our membership. Most recently we have had members complete funded first aid certificates from Northern Region, lifeguards attend the Intermediate Lifeguard School and the Youth Development Camp. We are looking forward to learning from their experiences.

Thank you to our lifeguards, our instructors, examiners and the families who support us and the community by loaning you to us to enable us to patrol our beach.

We could not have started off our 2017-2018 season any better, other than coming off the back of winning the following Sports awards at the Northern Region Awards of Excellence, held 12 August 2017:

- U16 Sportsman of the Year – Hamish Lockie
- U16 Sportswoman of the Year – Lucy Makaea
- Pool Champs Club of the Year
- Northern Region Champs, and
- Overall Competition Club of the Year

Along with these sports awards, the club was recognized as Best Patrolled Beach, which is testament to the dedication and commitment our sports athletes show when putting on the yellow and red uniform, symbolizing the heart of our organization. Surf Life Saving is a unique organization, offering its volunteers with a sports career path whilst giving back to the community. We are fortunate that Orewa embraces this as part of our club culture and supports all our athletes in their endeavours.

Training camps are a big part of the senior sports squad and are designed as a great platform for all the sports disciplines and non-competitive life-guards to come together, share ideas, and participate in team bonding activities. The first camp held in June 2017, has been hailed as one of the best camps held to date, with some thought provoking discussions culminating

in a newly formed set of values: R.E.A.L - Respect, Environment, Attitude, Leadership. Our club has embraced these values and implemented them across the wider club areas.

During the Winter months, many of our athletes take part in various Pool Championships events, with training starting in May and finishing up after the NZ Pool Champs event held mid- October. Last year, Orewa were still very much excelling in these events, coming a very close 2nd place at the Northern Region event, and a commendable 3rd at the NZ Champs. I would like to give a very special mention to Sandra Burrows who for the second year running, set two new world records, breaking her previous year's achievements in the Masters over 65 years class.

To top off our impressive 2017 season in the pool, congratulations to Cornielle Coetzee who has been included in the Black Fins Development Squad ahead of this seasons World Champs campaign.

Training is well underway again now for the 2018 pool events, and I wish all the swimmers the best of luck and look forward to cheering them on poolside.

After a number of years in hiatus, the IRB Racing team sport is again revving up a notch and become a firm feature as part of our senior sports programme. Expressions of interest went out in May 2017, and by July we had 2 teams set up with a training plan under way. We were very fortunate to have the knowledge and training expertise from our club patron Mark Mitchell passed to our eager teams, and with guidance and support from team manager Hayden McMullen, Faron Turner, and parents we were able to enter the teams into various events through-out the season. Podium finishes in two events – silver in the U19 Assembly Rescue at North Island Champs, and silver in the U22 Assembly Rescue at the Northern Region Champs – has cemented Orewa as a club to be on the look out for in coming years. Special thanks to Shane and his team from Sunset Beach, who also provided training sessions and support to our teams. Cross-club knowledge sharing at it's best, although they may be a little more cautious in giving too much away in the future!

As in previous years, Orewa has been well represented as part of the various Northern Region High Performance training squads, which ultimately lead into the competition team, with 15 athletes being selected to attend various training camps. Also hailing from Orewa, were the NR Team head coach, Team Manager and Assistant Team Manager, proving our club as a dominant growth area within the surf sports environment. Six of these athletes went on to compete at the 2018 New Zealand Representative Challenge held in January, all with podium finishes.

Our Boat crews continue to grow, with 6 crews competing during the season. All crews had podium finishes at Nationals, and Orewa narrowly missed out on becoming the overall Boat Champions, being pipped by 1 point by Titahi Bay! The young U19 Banditos crew had an impressive first season, with podium finishes in every event they entered, including an overall 3rd placing at the boat series. Very special mention to the U23 Women's Diamonds crew, who placed 1st overall in the boat series, and 1st in the short course at Nationals. They were selected as part of the 2018 New Zealand Representative Challenge team for Northern Region. And the

ultimate achievement, selection to represent New Zealand as the U23 Womens Development team, to compete against Australia at the annual Trans-Tasman Surf Boat Challenge, held in Sydney.

Our season officially came to an end after the 2018 National Champs held at Midway Beach, Gisborne 16-18th March. We had mixed results across all the ages, in very tough conditions, which saw the under 16 arenas being moved down to Waikanae Beach on day 2. With a smaller beach squad than in previous years, the athletes all competed to the very best of their ability, with podium places in many events. Orewa managed to hold on to 5th overall after the weekends racing, which shows how strong and determined we are to continue to be the best that we can be.

The outstanding achievements within the sports programme would not be possible without the commitment and support we receive from all the volunteer parents and helpers who turn up to trainings and events, allowing the athletes to concentrate on what they do best. We are also extremely fortunate as a club to have the on-going generosity of all our Business House Sponsors and individual donors, who continue to provide significant contributions which in turn enables us to keep our gear upgraded and allows new purchases of equipment when required.

And finally, as my first season as Chair of the Sports Operational Committee comes to a close, I would like to thank all the committee members for their support and guidance and relentless volunteer hours committed to making this another successful year for Senior Sports. We have enjoyed a great season, and I wish everyone much success for the coming year.
