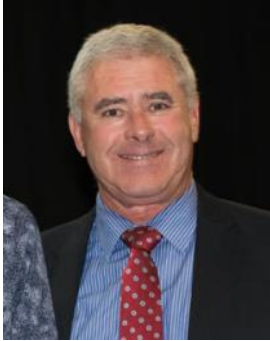

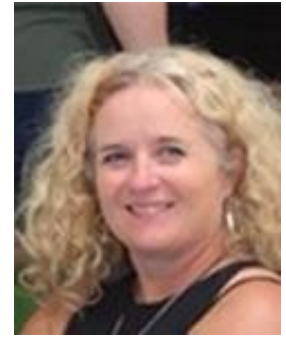

Lifesaving Chairs Report

This season has been one of reflection for me as my personal circumstances have taken me back to my birth country in Australia.

Often, we do not recognize, or are in the moment, as we live our lives, until a sudden change of circumstance takes place and forces us to acknowledge what is no longer there.

For me I miss my Orewa Surf Cub family and would like to sincerely thank you all for helping me and each other to grow and share our lives to create many beautiful memories. Memories stay with us forever and we will continue to cherish those memories of people who are no longer with us.

We have many things to be proud off as a club including who we are, as the people whom make up our membership.

We continue to volunteer our time to promote safety on our beaches and the statistics continue to demonstrate our contribution. This season was a little unique as we responded to Surf Life Saving NZ requesting a change to the patrolling hours. We responded to this by seeking advice from our membership who as always responded positively and created a flexible patrol roster. We performed a total of 61 patrols at Orewa and 12 at Wenderholm

Our contribution included:

4814 hours of volunteer life guarding.

16 rescues

15 searches

118 first aids

767 preventative actions, involving 4373 people.

This season we have continued to provide support to a number of life guarding events to our greater community and continue to develop relationships with our life guarding community and support to the smaller clubs.

We continue to grow as a club and introduce new candidates to the joy of life saving. The 2019 season we qualified approximately 22 more life guards and 5 more patrol support volunteers. As we qualify new life guards it is a constant reminder that it is the beginning of their life guarding journey and that there are so many pathways and opportunities to develop and grow. Our call out squad has been led by Tom Onley this year and he has introduced some training opportunities to increase their skill in responding to emergency situations. The tragedy that unfolded during a rescue on the Victorian coastline this April is always a reminder that our role can be dangerous so our training is an important aspect of our development.

We support our members in completing higher first aid certificates and encouraging our life guards to continue to attend the intermediate life guard school, youth development camp and the advanced and senior life guard awards. We are looking forward to learning from their experiences. Our members have also been involved in reviewing and rewriting sections of the lifeguard award manual which will be rolled out in the new season.

Thank you to our life guards, our instructors, examiners and the families who support us and the community by loaning you to us to patrol our beaches. We must always remember that we are not only keeping the beaches safe for our community but must keep ourselves safe in our life guarding duties.

Senior Sports Chairs Report

Surf Sports As in previous years, there is little respite for our Senior Sports Athletes and crews, as they continue to train through the Winter months in preparation for the season ahead.

During this time, our large contingent of pool swimmers spend hours fine-tuning their skills for the various pool championship events, comprising two Northern Region Inter-clubs, Northern Region Championships, and finishing with the New Zealand Pool Championships held in October.

2018 was no exception to the many hours put in by the swimmers, with the club overall attaining first place at the NR Champs, and first overall at the NZ Pool Champs. Again, our senior Masters swimmers were a formidable force, claiming first place at both coveted events. Training is well underway for the 2019 pool season, with a determined intent to hold on to both these awards.

Orewa athletes are also becoming regular attendees at Australian competitions with our pool swimmers competing at both the Queensland and Australian pool Champs events last season, securing podium finishes, and very close to breaking NZ records in the process. Two athletes went across to compete at the “Aussie” Nationals, up against very strong competition, with our very own Kees Ursem coming away with a silver medal in the U19 double ski event, competing for his “sister” club, Mermaid Beach. Special mention to Kate Wignell who competed at the World Surf Life Saving Champs held in Adelaide, November 2019, in both the pool and beach events, reaching the finals in some events, and gaining valuable experience whilst competing against the best in the World.

We are fortunate to have a strong coaching and team management structure in place to support our athletes. Head coach Zac Franich and team manager Cam Lockie have led the way for the past few years, ensuring our athletes are well prepared, with both also holding the Northern Region coach and team manager positions for the past 3 years. Zac has also successfully been named as the NZ Junior Black Fin coach, in a two-year volunteer capacity, which will see him take NZ Junior Black Fins to world events.

Along with the success of our coach and team manager, we had 4 athletes selected for the Northern Region Trans-Tasman Tri Series held in January 2019 - Hamish Lockie, Renee Benney, Sakura Gardiner and Harry Wenman. And with a further announcement of 3 athletes being selected for the New Zealand Youth Squad - Kendra Stinson, Kate Wignell and Hamish Lockie, is a further acknowledgement of the talent and depth of skilled athletes we are fortunate to have at Orewa.

Our boat and canoe crews enjoyed great success through the season. We have an U19 Womens Canoe crew for the first time in many years, who managed to ruffle the feathers of their competitors to come away with a Gold medal at NZ Nationals in the short course event, and a photo finish for 4th place in the long course. It should be noted the team is actually all U16 but compete in the higher age group. Special mention to volunteer coaches Warren Benney and Noel Kay for their unwavering support and guidance to this young crew.

The Orewa "Gems" Open Womens boat crew have had the season they have always dreamed of. Coming third overall in the NZ Boat Series, they topped off an impressive season with a gold and two silvers at NZ Nationals, under the guidance of their new sweep, Jake Griffiths. Our boat and canoe crews look set to increase in numbers for the upcoming season, and we hope to see the continued success in future years.

At time of writing this report, we have just received confirmation from Northern Region of the finalists for the Northern Region Awards of Excellence, with six of our senior athletes named in their respective individual categories. This summarises the depth of our talented athletes.

As always, we cannot run our events and camps, keep our gear in good order, or support the coaching without the wonderful volunteers and parents we have at the club. We are also extremely fortunate to have the continuous support from our Business House sponsors, and individual donors who dig deep every year to ensure we keep our successful sports programme running. The sports section of the club is an important membership retention tool, giving our valued life guards a platform to compete and excel in their chosen sport, whilst continuing to provide valuable volunteer hours needed during the busy Summer months at Orewa Beach.

Finally, thank you to the Sports Committee who contribute in so many areas of the Sports, keeping me busy and on my toes! It has been another very enjoyable and successful season for Orewa Senior Sports and I look forward to the year ahead.
